RE: Review of Procurement Activities During the Third-Quarter of FY2018 by the
Procurement Accountability Review Board

Under Sections V and VII of Mayor's Order 2018-019, the Procurement Accountability Review Board is required to convene at least quarterly at the call of the chairperson to review the following procurement matters: (1) contracts requiring retroactive approval by the Council of the District of Columbia, (2) decisions by the Contract Appeals Board or a court that overturn or invalidate a contracting action taken by the District, (3) audit findings, and (4) other procurement matters specifically referred to the Board. No member of the Board requested that a meeting be convened to either review discretionary procurement activities or review a retroactive contract action prior to its submission to Council for approval. Due to scheduling conflicts and other considerations, the Board will review all referred matters at its next meeting slated for the fourth-quarter of Fiscal Year 2018 (July 1, 2018 through Sept. 30, 2018).

Accordingly, the Chief Procurement Officer hereby gives notice that no meeting of the Procurement Accountability Review Board was convened during the period from April 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018.
